The Federal University of Santa Catarina is honored to invite you to be part of the II Latin American Symposium on Biostimulants in Agriculture that will be held this year with the consecrated IX Brazilian Meeting on Induction of Resistance in Plants to Pathogens. The joint event aims to stimulate the discussion on the use of biostimulants and inducers of resistance in agriculture, integrating technical-scientific knowledge with the productive sector and enabling dialogue between them.

The event will be held from **November 12 to 14, 2018** in Florianópolis, SC. The theme will be discussed in the format of sessions, composed of up to 03 speakers. Each speaker will have approximately 25 minutes of explanation. The organizing committee is taking care to make the event program as comprehensive as possible. Therefore, we invite you and your colleagues to submit proposals for individual sessions or lectures. If you are interested in participating as a speaker, we ask you to send the title of the lecture as well as a brief summary of what will be addressed. Proposals for individual lectures or sessions should be sent by e-mail (bioestimulantes2018@contato.ufsc.br) until March 20, 2018.

Organizers are struggling to get funding from development agencies and the private sector to support speakers with tickets and daily allowances. However, to date there are no guarantees of financial support to all and self-financing proposals are therefore very welcome. We ask you to report along with your proposal, whether it would be self-financing or whether any kind of support would be needed. Speakers are exempt from the registration fee at the event.
